Install the timing belt, starting on the crankshaft sprocket and working in a counterclockwise direction over all the sprockets, except the tensioner. The timing belt is routed behind the tensioner. Keep the belt tight between the crankshaft sprocket, the idler pulley and the camshaft sprocket on the non-tensioned side of the engine.

How do mechanics replace the timing belt? Engine designs vary, and thus the replacement procedure will vary, but broadly, the procedure is as follows: Disconnect the battery ground cable. Once the engine is cold, set the crankshaft to top dead center with the number one piston on the compression stroke. Remove crankshaft pulley.

Mazda recommends changing the timing belt every. The 2.5L V6 engine featured in the 1993 Mazda MX6 is a freewheeling engine, which means that should the belt break or stretch past its useful life, catastrophic engine damage most likely will not occur. Mazda recommends changing the timing belt every 96,561 km (60,000 miles), since previous use and service history shows that the belt stretches past its useful life at the 96,561 km (60,000 miles) mark under normal driving conditions.
