Answer: Shem, Ham, and Japheth were the three sons of Noah who along with their wives were carried in the ark during the great flood. Their descendants went on to re-populate the world (Genesis 10:1).

What is the biblical account of Shem, Ham, and Japheth ...

Noah's sons, Shem, Ham, and Japheth, and their wives, accompanied Noah and his wife on the ark to escape the flood. After the flood, Noah's sons and their wives and offspring repopulated the earth. The offspring of Shem inherited the Promised Land, displacing the Canaanites, the descendants of Ham. Shem and Japheth received Noah's blessing because they had covered their father's drunken nakedness, while Ham, on the other hand, violated their father by looking at his nakedness.

Because of the traditional grouping of people based on their alleged descent from the three major biblical progenitors (Shem, Ham, and Japheth) by the three Abrahamic religions, in former years there was an attempt to classify these family groups and to divide humankind into three races called Caucasoid, Mongoloid, and Negroid (originally named "Ethiopian"), terms which were introduced in the 1780s by members of the Göttingen School of History.

Genesis chapter 5:32 talks of Noah being 500 when he begat Shem, Ham and Japheth. Now, the Bible is very clear on what age people were when they had children but when it came to Noah it seems to be that Noah's children could have been triplets.

NOAH'S THREE SONS: Were they triplets? - Ask John Mackay ...

Japheth was the oldest (Genesis 10:21), and Ham was the youngest (Genesis 9:24). Japheth was born when Noah was 500 years old, and the flood came 100 years later (Genesis 7:6-7). Since Shem was 100 two years after the flood (Genesis 11:10), he must have been born when Noah was 502 years old.

The kings and priests, of Egypt, Sumeria, Babylonia, and Assyriawere the most powerful men on earth. Shem HAM, and Japheth

Japheth Japheth, from the Hebrew word meaning enlargement, is one of Noah's sons along with Shem and Ham. He is usually referred to as Yafeth bin Nuh or Japeth son of Noah in Arabic records. He was born when Noah was more than 500 years old.

Japheth first appears in the Hebrew Bible as one of the three sons of Noah, saved from the Flood through the Ark. In the Book of Genesis, they are always in the order "Shem, Ham, and Japheth" when all three are listed (Genesis 5:32, 9:18 and 10:1). However Genesis 9:24 calls Ham the youngest, and Genesis 10:21 refers ambiguously to Shem as "brother of Japheth the elder," which could mean that either is the eldest.

Japheth was probably 100 years old when the Flood came. Based on the genealogy in Genesis 11, it seems like Shem would have been about two years younger. Ham was the youngest brother, but we are not told how much younger he was.. What Did They Look Like?

Later in Genesis 9, Ham will be referred to as Noah's "younger" son. And when children are born to Shem, Ham, and Japheth, Japheth is referred as being older than Shem (Genesis 10:21). The references "younger" and "older" don't negate the possibility that these three weren't triplets.
